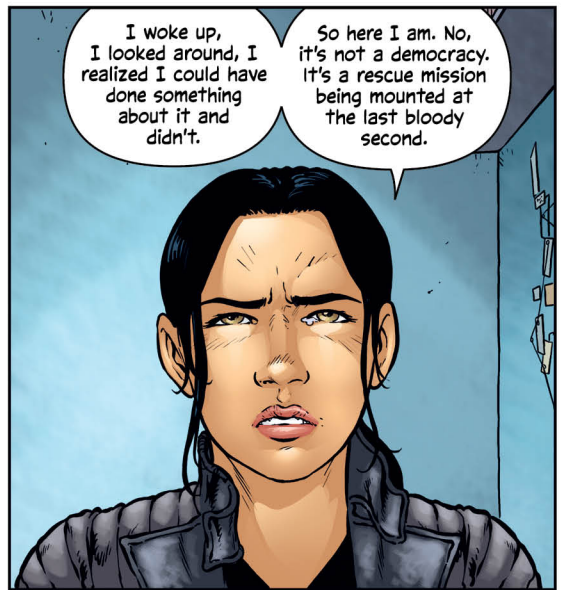


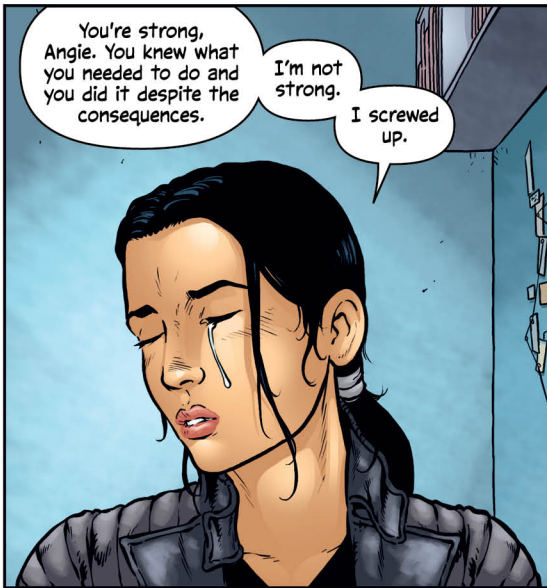
Yeah! The world got too much for me and I went away and got drunk for twenty years! I screwed up! Okay?

I woke up, I looked around, I realized I could have done something about it and didn't.

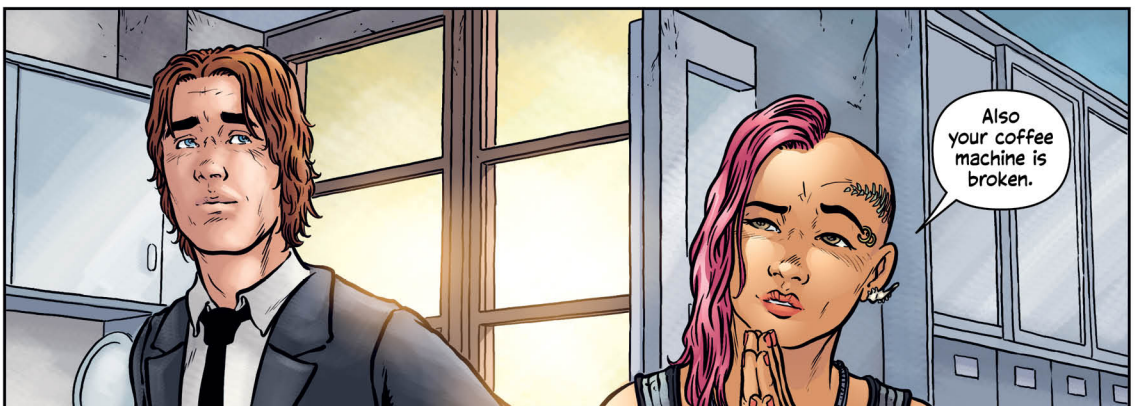
So here I am. No, it's not a democracy. It's a rescue mission being mounted at the last bloody second.
