Great. So hey, still waiting to hear how I figured out how to defeat the Frost Giants, who, I remind you, recently messed up your tail in a single hit.

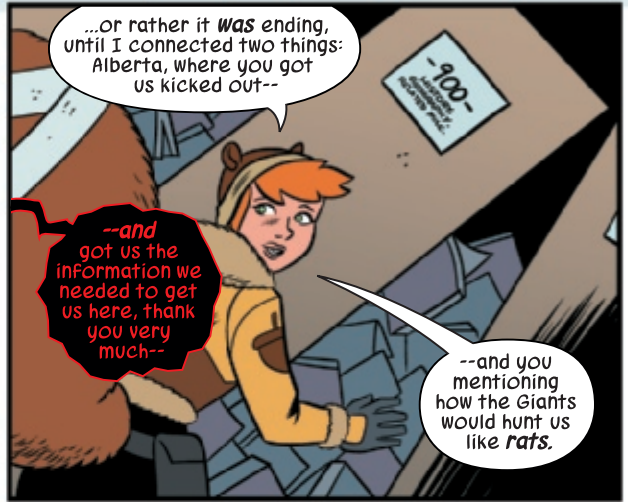
PFFT, it's a minor injury *at best*. But you can never be too safe against infection, especially when the world is ending...
